

COVID -19 has impacted us all, this means that compliance has changed. The best way to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and protect the students, staff and our business is through good hygiene practices.

Below are the measures we have in place to comply with the NSW Governments COVID-19 policies.

- Maintain and practice frequent hand washing during shifts, preparing foods, before and after breaks, when returning from the bathroom, and after touching the face or hair
- Maintain thorough cleaning and sanitising of facilities, equipment, and transport vehicles (including food contact surfaces and equipment, but also door handles, light switches, floors, walls, and other 'high touch' areas)
- Thoroughly cleaning surfaces with water and detergent and applying normally used cleaning agents is sufficient
- Temperature checks on all staff
- Frequent use of hand sanitiser, with ahand sanitising stations set up within the canteen, easily accesbile to delivery drivers and staff
- Anyone who has any flu like symptoms is excluded from the canteen until a Covid-19 test returns a negative result
- Delivery drivers are to wear a face mask and gloves when delivering. Gloves to be changed after each delivery
- Canteen is only accessible to essential staff and delivery drivers. There is limited access to the kitchen from school staff and no visitors allowed
- These measures are in addition to our day to day safe food handling procedures
